ELECTION DAY | August 19, 2025 (9:00 am to 4:00 pm)

The first Board of Governors meeting following the election will be **September 5, 2025.**

ELIGIBITY

In order to be a candidate or nominator, a BCGEU support staff member must be:

- employed by Coast Mountain College as support staff as of the notice of election date, and;
- a due paying member of the BCGEU Support Staff Bargaining unit, or;
- on leave which allows accrual of seniority.

NOMINATION

All Nominees are required to submit a typed candidate statement, no longer than 250 words in length, along with their completed nomination form.

Nomination forms are available through a Campus Administration Officer, Registration offices, or see any BCGEU representative.
