- Selection of hosts will be a thorough process, which will include hosts, must have red seal and certifications in the same regards as well as be a qualified host.
- Detailed discussions on Evaluation profile ensued: Students will have to demonstrate their skills and techniques learnt during the exchange as part of practical assessments. And professionalism will be monitored as a long-term evaluation by host and internal CMTN staff.
