

## STUDENT APPEAL OF SUSPENSION TO BOARD OF GOVERNORS FORM

Under the <u>BC College and Institute Act</u>, students have the right to appeal a suspension issued by the President to the Board of Governors. This process ensures that students are provided with a fair review of the suspension decision at their request.

The BC College and Institute Act, Section 37 states that:

- (2) For just cause, the president of an institution may suspend a student of the institution and deal summarily with a matter of student discipline;
- (3) On exercise of a power of suspension under this section, the president must immediately report the action to the board with a statement of the reasons;
- (4) A person suspended under this section has the right of appeal to the board.

Appeals of a suspension decision must be submitted by the student to the Board of Governors within 20 business days from the date the student was notified of the decision, by completing this form.

The completed appeal form must be submitted to the Director, President's Office.
