REGALIA AT CONVOCATION CEREMONIES POLICY

1.00 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this policy is to establish regulations governing the convocation ceremonies at Coast Mountain College in order to maintain the integrity and importance of the ceremony.

2.00 DEFINITIONS

2.1 **Regalia**: The distinctive clothing worn and ornaments carried at formal occasions as an indication of status.

3.00 POLICY STATEMENT

- 3.1 Graduates and members of the platform will be provided with a black gown and a black cap with a golden tassel to wear to the convocation ceremony.
- 3.2 Indigenous graduates and platform party may wear traditional clothing and regalia at convocation ceremonies.
- 3.3 Members of active-duty military may wear their dress uniforms.
- 3.4 Civil authorities required to wear a uniform while on duty may wear that uniform.
- 3.5 Members of religious orders may wear traditional regalia.
- 3.6 Platform party members may wear gowns and regalia related to their discipline.
- 3.7 Any other adornments must be authorized by the Registrar.
