
Plagiarism Checklist for Students at Coast Mountain College

Before submission for grading, I confirm I have:

- Made sure I have not paraphrased ideas too closely by making only small changes, and still retaining the same structure and words as the original.
- Reviewed every source carefully and have cited all ideas used from other sources.
- Re-read my submission carefully to make sure there is no section or component of my assignment, paper or research report that I do not understand.
- Checked carefully that the reference entries in my bibliography/works cited/reference list corresponds with every idea/quote I have used.
- Ensured that, other than material that is a direct quotation, everything else is in my own words.
- Made sure I have not added material attributed to a non-existent or incorrect source, nor made up material attributed to a real source.
- Asked an instructor or librarian about how to include any material I was unsure how to document.

Before submission for grading, I confirm I have not:

- Bought a paper online or from another student.
- Hired or let someone do your work for you.
- Sold papers to others or allowed others to copy my work.
- Submitted the same assignment twice or re-used papers I have submitted without citing it.
